ORDER OF DISMISSAL


This matter comes before this Tribunal pursuant to E.D.'s request for a final hearing. Petitioner appeals the decision of the Georgia Department of Juvenile Justice to revoke S.M.'s community placement. Prior to receiving substantive evidence in this matter, the parties agreed to an alternate plan as set forth below.

Both parties in this matter stipulated and agreed that:

1. S.M. will be released from detention with an electronic monitoring device attached to his ankle upon signing the terms and Conditions of Placement, which are incorporated as part of this agreement. S.M. will be placed on non-secure detention extension at his home address until such time that he is placed.
2. S.M. will be screened for placement on 02/12/14 at 3:00 p.m. and will remain on electronic monitoring until such time he is placed in accordance with the screening results.
3. In the event, S.M. is not placed before the expiration of the thirty day (30) day (sic) time period approved for electronic monitoring, a request for extension will be made for continued placement on the electronic monitor until he is placed.
4. S.M.'s case manager will make a referral for individual counseling for S.M. and Multi Systemic Therapy immediately following the screening process.
5. S.M. is expected to abide by all of the terms and Conditions of his Placement in order to remain on non-secure detention extension. Any violation of the terms and conditions of his release may result in his placement in detention.

The parties' alternate plan is accepted and constitutes a settlement of all issues that were the subject matter of this action. *See* Ga. Comp. R. & Regs. r. 616-1-2-.17(2). Accordingly, this matter is **DISMISSED**.
