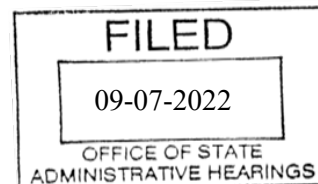

**ORDER**

This matter was referred to this tribunal on November 2, 2020. A Notice of Hearing was issued on November 4, 2020, scheduling a hearing for February 1, 2021. On January 15, 2021, the parties requested a continuance to a date not earlier than July 15, 2021. The undersigned granted the request and ordered the parties to file a joint status report on or before July 1, 2021. The parties complied, and on June 28, 2021, they requested additional time and proposed filing a joint status report on October 1, 2021.

The Court issued a Notice of Hearing re-setting the hearing for October 12, 2021. On August 19, 2021, the parties requested a continuance until December 2021. The undersigned granted this request and ordered the parties to file a joint status report no later than December 1, 2021. On November 30, 2021, the parties indicated that they were continuing to negotiate and hoped to reach a settlement. They requested that they be allowed to file a joint status report by February 15, 2022. The undersigned granted this request. On February 15, 2022, the parties requested and were granted additional time until May 16, 2022. On May 16, 2022, the parties requested and were granted additional time until June 30, 2022. On June 28, 2022, the parties requested additional time until August 2, 2022. On July 1, 2022, the Court ordered the parties to

file a joint status report no later than August 31, 2022.

Presently before the Court is a Joint Status Report and Motion for Continuance, filed on August 30, 2022, in which the parties state they are finalizing a settlement agreement and request additional time until October 15, 2022, which is over one year after the rescheduled hearing was to have occurred. The Court **DENIES** this request. Instead, the case shall be administratively closed, and the matter is hereby **REMANDED** to the agency. Should the parties wish to file a new request for a hearing, they may do so. O.C.G.A. § 50-13-41; Ga. Comp. R. & Regs. 616-1-2-.29.
